German composers were among the very best contributing to the European art of the Baroque.

They achieved an unparalleled mastery of form and technical sophistication. Their organ music was often very solemn, and, to some contemporary tastes, a bit ponderous.

This notable fact leads us to a very natural question: were these men of inordinate professional gravitas capable of a musical smile? We cannot entirely exclude such a hypothesis out of hand. There is much evidence that they responded enthusiastically to the new dashing Italian style, considerably lighter in tone and full of *joie de vivre*.

To exemplify such a contention, Andrzej Zahorski will perform organ arrangements of Italian concerti grossi by J. S. Bach and Johann Walther, Bach's close friend, along side other works more characteristic of these two composers.
